This year we are introducing [online PREP registration](#) to make it more convenient for our parents. The links can be found below. The first form requires your family information and registration for the oldest child in your family that will be registered for PREP. The other link will be necessary for each of your other children that you may be registering.

PLEASE NOTE, WE WILL ONLY PROCESS YOUR REGISTRATION ONCE YOUR PAYMENT HAS BEEN RECEIVED AND VERIFIED. We accept Debit / Credit / Cash / Cheque (payable to St. Patrick's Parish). Cash and Cheque payments can be submitted in the Sunday mass collection in an envelope clearly marked for PREP or dropped off at the parish office during regular office hours Monday to Friday (9am - 4pm (closed for lunch 12 noon to 1:15pm)). **DEADLINE IS JULY 15, 2018. LATE FEE OF \$25 WILL BE CHARGED AFTER THAT DATE.**

Our fee structure has also changed:

Registered Parishioners (using parish envelopes on a regular basis for the past year):

1 child = \$80

2 children = \$100

3+ children = \$130

Non-Registered Parishioners (not using envelopes and inconsistent use):

1 child = \$100

2 children = \$120

3+ children = \$150

Sacrament Fees:

First Holy Communion (grade 2) = \$25

Confirmation (includes Spirit Day) = \$75

Sacramental PREP (grade 4+ students receiving FHC) = \$30
