PLEASE NOTE, WE WILL ONLY PROCESS YOUR REGISTRATION ONCE YOUR PAYMENT HAS BEEN RECEIVED AND VERIFIED. *We accept Debit / Credit / Cash / Cheque (payable to St. Patrick’s Parish). Cash and Cheque payments can be submitted in the Sunday mass collection in an envelope clearly marked for PREP or dropped off at the parish office during regular office hours Monday to Friday (9am - 4pm (closed for lunch 12 noon to 1:15pm)).*
